Award winning soprano and actress Michelle Todd was born and raised in the mining town of Sutton in Ashfield in Nottinghamshire, England. She began singing in the church choir and in school productions and started taking voice lessons at the age of 10. Her early performing years were as a member of the multi-award winning ensemble Cantamus, with whom she sang in Germany Switzerland, Holland, Hungary and Bulgaria.

Her roles in London Theatres include HMS PINAFORE, Stephen Sondheim's FOLLIES, LITTLE ME, THE SOUND OF MUSIC, LITTLE SHOP OF HORRORS, PRAVDA, BLESS THE BRIDE AND TWELFTH NIGHT. A residency at the Banff Centre included performing the role of *Daisy* in the opera SHIVAREE and the musical SASHA. She has starred at the Shaw Festival, the Citadel Theatre, Edmonton, and performed across Canada in the voice/harp duo Amata and was profiled for Bravo! Television.
